

Behind Martell, Myers, & Callahan, Randolph Oilers even their record

Cornerback Charles Williams returned an interception 80 yards for a touchdown, helping give the visiting Randolph Oilers a 7-6 Eastern Football League victory over the Rhode Island Prowlers Saturday.

After Williams' third-quarter score, Dave Canavan booted the decisive extra point.

Williams garnered EFL Defensive Player of the Week honors, as he also recovered a fumble and forced another for the Oilers (1-1).

Rhode Island scored with 2:59 left in the game, but John Martell, Kevin Callahan and Tony Vanaria (nine unassisted tackles) broke through the line to stuff former New England Patriots running back Harold Shaw on the two-point conversion try.

Randolph quarterback Ryan Myers (7-for-15, 78 yards) completed five passes for 55 yards to former Avon-Holbrook High School teammate Joe Callahan.

Randolph will host the Brockton Buccaneers at 8 p.m. Friday at Randolph High School.
