The Randolph Oilers fell to the Taunton Gladiators on Saturday 36-17 in a game played at Taunton high school.

The loss secured the Oilers position in the playoffs after Hyde Park lost in their last game of the season.

The Oilers will face the top team in the Eastern Football League in the Western Massachusetts Blitzin' Bears who are 9-1 and will be playing at home to open the playoffs.

Taunton looks to have the second seed in the playoffs with their overall record of 9-2 this season. The Oilers have completed their regular season with a record of 4-7. Beset by injuries to key players throughout the season, the Oilers struggled with consistency on both sides of the ball but secured their playoff bid in a close game against Hyde Park three weeks ago.

Randolph is led by quarterback Ryan Myers and wide receivers Brian Gallo and Will Price and will face Western Massachusetts in the first round of the playoffs on Oct. 1.
